Christmas Tree Festival

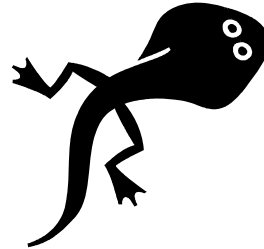

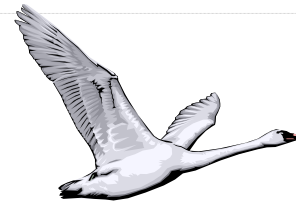
Cygnets and Ducklings will be spending time looking at Autumn. Ducklings are going to create an autumn board with some of their children's art work. There will be lots of opportunity for the children to experience texture and smell while they are doing lots of messy play activities

Tadpoles will be talking about Bonfire night and Halloween. They have said that children can dress up for Halloween if they would like. They will be making pumpkins and glittery firework pictures as well as doing lots of cooking.



Kingfishers are going to spend time discussing Halloween and Bonfire night. They are going to carve a pumpkin and explore the texture of pumpkin. They will be marble painting fireworks and making the role-play into a rocket. The children will spend time exploring texture during messy play.

Swans are learning about Autumn, Halloween and Bonfire Night. They will be doing lots of art work including glittery pictures and bats. Their role-play area has been changed into a builders yard. Swans have asked if children can bring in photos of special things they have been doing at home.
